Students are invited to participate by audition. We offer showcase competition teams for all ages; Pee Wee (1st-3rd grade), Pre-Teen (4th-6th grade), Junior (7th-9th grade), and Youth (10th-12th grade). These teams consist of partnered Ballroom Teams with gents and ladies, Theater Arts (Lift) Teams, and All Ladies Teams. Please see our Tuition document to see how many hours each team rehearses.

Our season begins Monday, August 25th, 2025 and ends Friday, April 24, 2026. Look at our team commitment & preliminary schedule to see what is required to participate and what we have planned for next year.

TEAM COMMITMENT & PRELIMINARY SCHEDULE

<u>Premier Calendar</u> - Our season teams & classes begin August 25th, 2025 and ends April 24th, 2026. I understand that the calendar provided below is what is required of my dancer to participate on a competition or medley team. Premier follows the Davis School District school calendar regarding holiday breaks. We DO NOT cancel or close the studio on professional development days.

- <u>July 8th-July 31st</u>: Summer Technique classes take place Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday mornings (Minimum class requirement is one Latin & one Standard per week for 4 weeks in July, with additional optional classes available. Registration for classes opens after auditions and is part of team acceptance). **REQUIRED** for all dancers on Showcase Competition, Medley teams & Ladies Competition teams.

Additional Team Commitment Information

• A rehearsal/class schedule <u>(Studio Weekly class schedule)</u> will be provided a week after auditions. Most teams and classes will run similarly to Premier's 2024-25 schedule, but know that some changes will likely occur based on who auditions and what teams we have for the following year. All teams are a season-long commitment, from August 2025 through the beginning of May 2026. Premier's detailed full year participation calendar will be provided in August (for now please refer to the calendar provided above). To accept a team spot, one must register for the class on Studio pro and register for required July technique classes.

• Youth Medley Teams will have a max of 10 extra practices throughout the season, to prepare for performances, competitions, etc. These practices will be scheduled and listed on our season calendar that will be provided in August. All extra practices will either take place on a Friday or Saturday.

• Early withdrawal from a team or class requires a **30-day notice** submitted through our **Class Drop Request Form**. If notice is received **before the 5th** of the month, the student is only responsible for that month's tuition. If the form is submitted **on or after the 5th**, the student will also be charged for the **following month's tuition**. Please note that sending your student to tell their coach that they are dropping is not sufficient notification and will not be considered an official drop request. Additionally, an informal text to staff will not be considered.

• If we have a team with more than 8 ladies/gents, all dancers will have the opportunity to "spot share" throughout the season. ALL dancers are guaranteed to compete in at least one medley/show dance per competition and perform in BOTH medleys and all show dances in at least one of the two shows at the Spring Concert. Please remind your dancers that this is a team sport, and everyone needs an opportunity to shine on the floor and often we need to share spots. The exception is if a dancer misses 3 or more rehearsals in a row, and at that point is up to the coach's discretion.

• Youth Showcase/Medley dancers have the option to travel with Premier on a Summer Tour in June 2026. More detailed information regarding this tour will be released at our parent meeting on Saturday, September 6th, 2026.

• Showcase Competition & Medley team dancers are **REQUIRED** to take a weekly syllabus/technique class as part of their team commitment. Students taking our technique classes have the **OPTION** to use the syllabus technique routines learned in class for individual competition. <u>Showcase Competition students</u> are **REQUIRED** to compete in at least two (2) competitions with a partner during the season (Solo, Syllabus, AND/OR Open). <u>Medley team students</u> are **REQUIRED** to compete in at least three (3) competitions with a partner in the season (Solo, Syllabus, AND/OR Open). <u>Medley team students</u> Open). We would like ALL competition students to fill out a "Competition Intent Form" at the beginning of the season so that we can help everyone accomplish this requirement.

• Showcase & Medley team students are REQUIRED to take their medals exams at the end of the season.

• If a student misses rehearsals the week before/of the performance/competition, they potentially forfeit their spot in the choreography. This is left up to the discretion of our coaches and director. We understand there are extenuating circumstances and it is up to the parent (NOT STUDENT) to communicate this with the coaches and director so that an appropriate decision can be made.

• To help keep costs down, each competition family is **required to complete a minimum of 10 service hours** during the season. Parents and students can sign up to assist with various activities, including studio parties, competitions, performances, costume preparation, and more. Families may choose to **"buy out" their service hours at a rate of \$10 per hour**, allowing us to hire additional help or compensate teachers for extra work if needed. For the **2025-2026 season**, our Youth Program Coordinator, **Carli Ralph**, will manage service hour sign-ups and track completed hours.

CLASS, PERFORMANCE, & COSTUME ATTIRE REQUIREMENTS

Class & Team Attire - team members are required to wear the following to class and team. We ask that the style of clothing you select be comfortable and modest. **NO JEANS, NO CROP TOPS, NO SHORT SHORTS, OR SPANX**. We also require ladies to wear hair in a clean ponytail or bun that will stay and not fall out.

- Black Latin Pants OR comparable

- Patent Leather Ballroom Shoes

LADIES:

- Black Short/Long Sleeve Leotard OR Premier Shirt

Performance Attire - Team members will be required to provide their own <u>performance basics</u>. Information on where to purchase and examples of items needed will come in a separate document.

- Latin Shoes (can be the same ones used in class)
- Patent Leather Ballroom Shoes (can be the same ones used in class)

- Tan Satin Latin Shoe (Block shoe for Pre-Teens)
- Tan Standard Shoe (Pre-Teens do NOT need)
- Dark Suntan Tights & Fishnets (Pre-Teen NO fishnets)
- Black Briefs
- Nude Leo (Lower back w/clear straps)
- Team Warm-up jacket OR Premier Shirt
- Tanning Lotion (only for Juniors & Youth)
- Hair and Makeup basics

Dance Shoes - Students are **<u>REQUIRED</u>** to purchase their own dance shoes, and they must wear what is listed above to class and team. Please do <u>**NOT**</u> purchase dance shoes until examples are given.

<u>**Tanning for Shows/Competitions**</u> - Tanning is <u>**REQUIRED**</u> for performances (except Pee Wee & Pre-Teens dancers). I understand that my student needs a little color to make sure they are not "washed" out under bright white lights on stage when performing.

_____ *Hair & Makeup* - Video & Pictures on how to do hair and makeup will be provided the closer we get to our first competition/performance. We are working on starting a youtube channel with this information!

COMMUNICATION / PARENT EXPECTATIONS:

Forms of Communication - The studio and our teachers will communicate with you in several different ways. We primarily use the BAND app for studio and team communication. Instructions on when/how to download will come after auditions. Lastly, we use e-mail and team moms as an additional way of communication. Carli Ralph will be in charge of helping us arrange team moms for the 2025-26 season.

Concerns/Questions - IF students have any concerns that **DO NOT** directly deal with the coach of the team or teacher of a class, the student will send an email directly to the Premier email. The owner and director, Krista Derington, will then make a decision on how to handle the situation. Our team coaches and class teachers will ONLY deal with what their job entails. If the student is unsure who to contact, we ask they start by contacting Krista through the Premier email: premierballroomacademy@gmail.com

_____ *Parent/Family Expectations* - We would like to re-emphasize the need for families to complete 10 service hours at some point during the season.

TUITION & STUDIO FEES:

Registration Fee - A non-refundable annual registration fee of \$45 for your first dancer, and \$20 per additional sibling is required for both new and returning students. To secure your dancer's team spot, the following must be completed by **June 5th**:

- 1. Register for the July Summer Technique classes
- 2. Pay the annual registration fee

Failure to complete both steps by the deadline may result in forfeiting the dancer's spot.

<u>Studio Pro & Automatic Payment</u> - Premier uses a secure on-line merchant platform called Studio Pro to bill and keep track of students/families accounts. All students/parents are required to login to their account and sign our online waiver(s) once they have been placed on a team for the 2025-26 season. Students/Families are welcome to make payments online with a credit/debit card, <u>and are required to have a card on file</u>. Families have the option to be automatically billed for monthly/year tuition, workshops, merchandise, etc (<u>we highly recommend</u> <u>this to avoid missing payments and being charged late fees</u>). There is an approximately 3% merchant/convenience fee when credit cards are charged. You are also welcome to pay with cash/check and must do so via the secure studio drop box before the 5th of each month, or your card on file will automatically be charged.

Tuition - I understand that it is my responsibility to review Premier's Tuition & Fee document to find my dancer's monthly or annual tuition amounts. I may choose to pay tuition:

- Monthly (due by the 5th of each month to avoid a \$10 late fee) OR
- Annually (at a slightly discounted rate)

I acknowledge that there are no credits or refunds for missed classes or class cancellations. However, Premier will make every effort to reschedule cancelled classes. *I understand that if my student misses any workshops, boot camps, or special classes with a choreographer, I am still responsible for the associated fees, as this is a team sport and all costs are budgeted for the year. Expenses are intended to be evenly split among all team members.* By initialing, I agree to pay the tuition as outlined on the Tuition & Fee document.

Team tuition covers the following:

Open Studio Practice Hours
 Team Rehearsal Hours
 Once a Week Technique Class
 Extra Practices
 Medals Exams (partnering comp teams)
 Team Pictures (NOT individual pictures)

Competition Fee - The competition fee covers the team's registration, guest coaching sessions, the team coach's attendance, and additional related expenses. The cost is **\$40/dancer per competition** attended with their team. Accounts will be billed for each competition **at least one month prior to the event**. This fee **does not include event admission or individual competition entry fees** as these costs vary by event and are subject to change.Dancers competing individually are responsible for managing their own registrations. To assist with this process, we will be offering a class/zoom meeting at the beginning of the season to guide parents through individual competition.

Costume Fee - There is a **non-refundable** annual Costume Rental Fee due by August 5th. Costumes remain the property of Premier Ballroom Academy. This fee is the same for boys and girls, even though girls'

costumes cost significantly more. All costs need to be fairly spread out amongst all team members since this is a team effort. Costume fees are based on teams, not individuals.

Winter Performance Fee - At the end of November/beginning of December (depending on the year) we do service performances. We take Premier competition and performance team dancers to perform for a senior living center & at the Festival of Trees in Sandy, UT (fundraising event for Intermountain Children's Hospital). The fee to participate is \$15 per student and helps cover our time to organize the performance and pay our teachers to attend. This fee is due by November 5th.

Spring Concert Fee - The Spring Concert Fee of \$45/dancer is due at the beginning of Winter Semester on January 5th. Each dancer is only charged this fee once, regardless of how many teams they are participating in. This fee helps cover the cost of venue rental, teacher assistance during the event, banquet attendance for that dancer, and a digital download of the concert, professionally filmed by our videographer.

STUDENT EXPECTATIONS:

Studio Rules (Please go through these with your dancers):

• No food is ever allowed in the dance studios. Please keep all food in the lobby. **NO NUTS!** We have several students with severe nut allergies. Students are allowed a water bottle in the studios.

• Please do not drop students off more than 15 min early to class. Please be courteous and pick up students on time. If your student is in the last class of the day, you need to pick them up promptly when class ends.

• Our parking situation is not ideal. We are allowed 6 parking spots out in front. You are NOT allowed to park in any other spaces besides ours before 5pm. After 5pm you are welcome to park anywhere that is open (even spots with signage). You are NOT allowed to wait and block other cars from entering the parking lot. If it's a quick pick up, that is fine. If we see you sitting and waiting longer than 5 minutes we may need to ask you to leave and wait somewhere else.

No cell phones, Kindles/tablets, Gameboys, or electronics of any kind should be out in the dance studios. If any of these items are used during class time students will receive a warning, and the 2nd/3rd offense our teachers have permission to take electronics that are being disruptive and will need to be picked up by the parent.
BE KIND. Premier does not tolerate bullying, meanness, and gossiping. If you already participate in these activities, this studio is not for you. We take this seriously and will dismiss a student and/or parent from the studio

if needed.

• Premier students will not participate in anything illegal. Doing so may be cause for immediate removal from Premier. (Drugs, alcohol, cigarettes, and shoplifting are some examples) If needed, a parent/dancer/teacher meeting will be scheduled.

Contract Amendment Clause

Premier Ballroom & Dance Academy (Premier) reserves the right, at its discretion, to amend the Team Contract, associated Team Fees, and related policies as it deems necessary. Any Team Contract amendments will be published on Premier's website and will take effect **thirty (30) days after publication**.

It is the responsibility of studio clients to stay informed of current and updated information. Premier is not liable for any client's lack of awareness regarding changes. In the event of a conflict between the original Contract and an amendment, the terms of the amendment shall prevail.

If Premier brochures, course offerings, team fees, literature, or website information are revised, **only the most recent version** will apply to current studio client accounts.

Policy Enforcement Waiver

Premier Ballroom & Dance Academy's decision not to enforce any part of its **Contract or Policies** or to allow flexibility with team requirements does not waive its right to require full compliance at any time. Any waiver or exception must be provided **in writing** by an **authorized officer of Premier** to be considered valid.

A waiver of a specific policy requirement does not affect Premier's right to enforce that requirement with other clients, nor does it impact the enforcement of other policies. Additionally, any delay or choice not to act on a policy violation does not waive Premier's right to address that or any future violation.
