Tuition & Fees Document for Ballroom Competition Teams

We received some feedback about the structure of how we used to bill for things, and we listened! We are excited to announce that beginning this season, Premier has restructured our fee schedule to make budgeting easier for our families. Rather than being billed separately as they came due throughout the year, the following fees are now combined into one total amount, divided evenly across nine monthly payments:

- Regular Season Tuition (End of August–April)
- August Boot Camp & Extra Before-School Practices
- Track A* **OR** Track B* Student
- *Team Competition Fees associated with their team (Does NOT include entrance into competitions)*
- All Performance Fees: Winter Performance, Festival of Trees/Senior Living Centers, & Spring Concert
- Unlimited Studio Practice
- Team Photos
- Medal Exams

The only fees that remain billed separately are the **Annual Registration Fee**, **July Technique Classes**, and the **Costume Fee**. This structure allows families to plan ahead with a consistent, predictable monthly payment from the start.

Track A includes weekly 1-hour syllabus choreography class & Track B includes floor rental fees for 4 lessons per month starting August 2026 (32 lessons total over the school year)

FAQs

What does the “Track A: Syllabus Choreography Class” option include?

In addition to their regularly scheduled team rehearsal & technique class times, Track A students will also be enrolled in a 1-hour per week syllabus choreography class where they will learn syllabus routines that can be used for individual competition events (solo ladies or with a partner). Additionally, the teacher of their choreography class will assist students & parents in registering the dancers for their individual competition events. Please note that this service does NOT include the competition registration fees or the competition entry ticket. The registration fees will be charged to each dancer's Studio Pro account and the competition entry ticket will be purchased directly from the event organizers.

What does the “Track B: Private Lesson Competition Training” option include?

Students who choose not to enroll in the Syllabus Choreography Class may fulfill their individual competition preparation through private lesson training arranged through the studio. This option requires participation in a minimum of four (4) private lessons per month (one 45-minute lesson each week or one double lesson every other week) with our current coaching staff. Lessons may be taken with a dance partner or as solo coaching designed to support competition preparation.

When a student chooses Track B, they will let us know whether they are taking lessons solo or with a partner. This will help determine their tuition rate through the studio. **Track B tuition includes the studio book/floor rental fees** for four lessons per month (32 total in the season). Private lesson instruction fees are paid separately and will vary based on the coach they choose to work with. Please note that in the past, coaches have included floor rental fees as a part of their lesson rates. Starting in August 2026, coaches will NO LONGER include those floor fees, which means their lesson rate will likely lower since the studio will be collecting floor fees directly.

This training pathway provides an alternative to the Syllabus Choreography Class while still maintaining consistent coaching and competition preparation.

How much do private lessons cost?

Private lessons are typically 45-minutes long and costs vary by coach. Premier's coaches range from \$40/lesson to \$80/lesson. If the lesson is for a single student, that cost will be the sole responsibility of that dancer. If a couple is taking the lesson together, the cost will be split between the two dancers.

If we choose Track B, are parents required to schedule time to use the studio or is that something the instructor does?

Premier will have rooms that are regularly available to use for private lessons and will be scheduled/reserved by the coach. Parents will simply need to coordinate with the coach to schedule their lesson time and then the coach will handle making sure they have a room to use.

If we choose Track B, how many total private lessons is my dancer required to get during the season?

Track B students are expected to take 4 private lessons per month, starting in August. Due to Winter Break and Spring Break, December and April will be counted as ½ months, requiring only 2 private lessons for each of those months. This gives 7 whole months and two half months for a total of 8 months worth of lessons, or 32 total over the season. That said, we understand that lives can get complicated and sometimes schedules need to be flexible, so if a dancer needs to have a month where they take five lessons and then do only three the following month, we are willing to work with you (within reason). Please do not wait until February to start taking lessons and try to cram 32 lessons into two and half months.

How do we schedule a private lesson?

Parents (or responsible dancers) will communicate directly with the coach of their choice to schedule their private lesson(s). In the event of needing to cancel or reschedule a lesson, a 24-hour cancellation notice is required. Lessons cancelled with less than 24-hours notice will still be charged the full lesson rate, except in cases of illness or emergency, which will be determined at the studio's discretion.

How do I choose a coach for my dancer?

We suggest that parents and dancers work with their technique and/or syllabus choreography class teacher for private lessons. We also suggest that parents and dancers work with a teacher that is proficient in that style of dance. This may mean a different coach for different styles. If the preferred teacher is not available, then we are happy to make a suggestion.

Do I have to sign in when I come in for Track B? Or for private lessons/practicing?

Yes, we need everyone to continue to sign in until further notice.

When Premier brings in professional guest coaches for additional training opportunities, can lessons taken with those professionals count toward fulfilling the requirements of a Track B student?

Yes! We want everyone to have the opportunity to train with the professionals we bring in if they would like to.

Why does the 2026-27 monthly tuition seem to be so much more expensive than last season?

At first glance, the monthly tuition rate certainly does seem to be a lot higher. HOWEVER, when you consider how it is calculated, it's actually not that much of an increase.

In past years, Premier has charged monthly tuition PLUS additional August Boot Camp fees, Competition fees, Winter Performance fees, and Spring Concert fees. Those fees can feel like they pop up out of nowhere and are especially stressful when several hit right after Christmas.

In an effort to simplify family financial planning and alleviate some of the stress that comes in January, we have COMBINED all of those above fees into one lump sum. Then we took the additional costs related to each syllabus track and added that total to that tuition+fees lump sum to find out what the total annual cost of each track would be. We then took that overall annual cost and divided it by 9 (August-April) and *voilà!*, that is where the new monthly tuition payment comes from.

What this means is that the only extra fees that you will pay on top of your monthly tuition is 1) the annual registration fee, 2) the July Technique Classes fee, and 3) the annual costume rental fee. The first two we charge separately because they occur before regular weekly classes

commence in August. The costume fee we charge as a lump sum in August because that fee is what pays for new costumes and our vendors require payment up front.

One other thing to note is that several teams will have more rehearsal time for this upcoming season than they did last year. For example, Junior Medley Blue is gaining 3 extra hours of August Boot Camp instruction and 1 extra hour of weekly regular season rehearsal. All of the Ladies teams are also gaining an extra 30 minutes of weekly instruction. Increased class time means higher tuition costs overall.

Why is the monthly tuition for an All Ladies second+ competition team so much cheaper than a first team?

If a lady is participating in both a partnered competition team and an all ladies competition team, the assumption is that she will fulfill her syllabus track requirement with her partnered team tuition. This means that her ladies team tuition will NOT include track A or B expenses. Additionally, the Winter Performance fee and the Spring Concert fee are per dancer, which means those fees will also be taken care of in their partnered team expenses.

The Ladies second+ team monthly tuition includes: *discounted* monthly tuition, August Boot Camp fee, and the team Competition fees. It does *not* include their July Technique Class fee or their annual costume rental fee.

What if I want to start getting my competition choreography early? How does that affect Track B floor fees during the season?

We understand that some dancers like to get a headstart on choreography so they can participate in August competitions. If your dancer would like to start their choreography (Track B) lessons in the summer, Premier is happy to make that accommodation as long as parents clearly communicate with Krista to determine what that adjustment will look like. Accommodations are not guaranteed and will be determined on a case-by-case basis.

Can I use the studio for practice? How do I find out when an open dance studio is available for practice?

Yes, all dancers participating in our program are welcome to come use the space when we list it as open on our google calendar. Our google calendar can be found near the bottom of the home page of our website. We are in the process of updating the calendar for summer, so please hang tight until after auditions to see our summer schedule.

What do I wear to the team auditions on May 23rd?

All dancers should wear dance/athletic clothing that they can move freely in and that follow Premier's dress code. Gents should be in Latin pants or dark colored pants, a white dress shirt or syllabus dance shirt, and a tie. Ladies should wear a black syllabus leotard or dark colored shirt/thick-strap tank top with either a dance skirt (with shorts beneath) or fitted leggings. All clothing should conform to the following restrictions: no spaghetti straps, no bare midriffs, no crop tops, no low backs (below the bra line), etc, and all skirts and shorts should be mid-thigh length or longer.
